As of May 26, a total of 27 persons have signed up for the picnic which translates to about 11 or 12 cars. Once the 15-car-limit is reached, the driver will be required to pay the \$8.00 parking fee.
- 3. Any guest driving his or her car will not be counted towards the 15-car-limit; the guest will be required to pay the \$8.00 fee.

Our annual Stammtisch get-together is scheduled for June 25 at Mimi's Café located at the corner of Oracle and Wetmore. The dinner prices range from approximately \$8.00 to \$18.00 plus tax and gratuity. Please contact me to let me know that you plan to attend this activity. 
