GACT, we have a problem.

After informing all members in the last two newsletters that a reservation for attending the annual picnic at the Crisp Ranch must be made with Jean Brett by April 13 (or sooner), a total of 51 persons made reservations and some of those made reservations literally the day before the picnic. The actual number of attendees was 75. It is almost impossible to plan a gathering when almost 50% more persons show up than was planned for; the cooks actually had to limit the food until everyone had at least one sausage before hungrier persons could have more food. After discussing this issue with some board members, it was decided that, in the future, persons who didn't reserve a spot for dinner at a dance or picnic would not be served until all of the "reserved spots" had eaten. We will not have the same entertainment for the April dance next year.

The picnic on Sunday, April 27, at Gina and Tom Crisp's ranch was attended by 75 persons and was very successful (except for the reservation thing mentioned above); even the weather was perfect and everyone appeared to have a great time. The sausages were

excellent (thanks Bernie and Hermann for cooking) as were all of the side dishes brought by the members. Again, I would like to thank everyone for their contributions and a special "Thank You" to Gina and Tom Crisp for their generosity for the use of their beautiful ranch.

The Stammtisch outing on Wednesday, May 14, to Angelika's German Imports in Sierra Vista was attended by 36 members and guests. It was a great way for friends to get together, to chat, and get to know each other a little better.
