German Holidays: January & February

January 1: New Year's Day (Neujahrstag) - The first day of the modern Gregorian calendar is a public holiday in Germany.

January 6: Epiphany (Heilige Drei Koenige) – Epiphany, also known as the 'Three Kings Day' is a major Christian celebration alongside Easter and Christmas. It marks the official end of Christmas, and according to Christian tradition, it is the day when the three wise men arrived in Bethlehem with gifts for baby Jesus, a few days after his birth. In Germany, it is a regional holiday in the states of Baden-Württemberg, Bavaria, and Saxony-Anhalt.

February 28: Fasching (Karneval) - In some cities in Germany, large carnivals take place on the Thursday (Fat Thursday), Monday (Rose Monday), and Tuesday (Fat Tuesday) before Ash Wednesday. This period is known in southwest Germany as Fastnacht, as Fasching in Bavaria

and Austria, and as Karneval in the Rhineland. Although not an official public holiday in Germany, normal work may be affected by the festivities in cities with large carnivals, such as Cologne, Frankfurt, and Munich.

March 8: International Women's Day (Tag der Frau) – In 2019, Berlin became the first federal state in Germany to observe the day as a regional holiday.
