I am happy to report that our June 10, Stammtisch at the Trident Grill II was very well attended. We had a total of 37 members and guests. The manager of the Trident was very accommodating to our club and a pleasure to work with. We plan to go back again next year.

Arizona Trivia –

- 1. What is the Arizona state flower?
- ✓ The Saguaro Cactus Blossom is a pure white waxy blossom of the giant saguaro cactus. It was designated the state flower of Arizona in 1931. The giant saguaro cactus (Cereus giganteus) is indigenous to Arizona; it grows to a height of forty to fifty feet and lives and age of 150 to 200 years.



- 2. What is the date on which Arizona achieved statehood?
- ✓ More than 100 years ago, Arizona became the last of the contiguous U.S. states to be signed into statehood, but it did not happen so easily. On Feb. 14, 1912, President William Howard Taft signed Arizona into the Union. Arizona was a territory for 49 years before it became a state.
- 3. At ~12,600 ft, what is the highest natural point in Arizona?
- ✓ Topping out at 12,633 feet, Humphreys Peak is the highest point in Arizona. It's one of the three peaks of San Francisco Mountain, an eroded stratovolcano north of Flagstaff.
- 4. Which Road in Tucson was once labeled the ugliest street in America?
- ✓ Tracing back to Tucson's 1962 mayor, East Speedway (approximately Tucson Boulevard to Wilmot Road) earned its nickname, in

part, for its once endless row of unsightly neon signs, billboards, inadequate setbacks and unattractive buildings. His statement almost certainly was intended to draw attention to the problem on this busy thoroughfare to get something done about it.


